What You Need to Know about Overdrafts and Overdraft Fees

An <u>overdraft</u> occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction, but we pay it anyway. We can cover your overdrafts in two different ways:

- 1. We have an <u>Overdraft Privilege Program</u> that comes with your account.
- 2. We also offer <u>coverdraft</u>. That is a link to a savings account, which may be less expensive than our standard overdraft practices. To learn more, ask us about these plans.

This notice explains our **Overdraft Privilege Program**.

What is the Overdraft Privilege Program that comes with my account?

We <u>do</u> authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments

We do not authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions unless you Opt In:

• Everyday debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction.

If we do <u>not</u> authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

You must bring your account balance positive once every 30 days.

What fees will I be charged if First Federal Savings Bank pays my overdraft?

Under our Overdraft Privilege Program:

- We will charge you a fee of \$30 each time we pay an overdraft
- There is a \$150 daily limit on the total fees we can charge you for overdrawing your account
